I would to thank the SRF for supporting my attendance at the 62^{nd} Annual Meeting of the Society for Reproductive Investigation in San Francisco, CA, USA.

At the SRI meeting this year I was invited to speak about my work at the satellite symposium; a key part of the meeting in which leaders in the field discuss the latest advances in endometrial research. I presented a 30 minute talk entitled 'Think global, act local: Regulation of the endometrial microenvironment in reproductive health and disease' in which I described our latest results on the novel role of local hormone production and action in the regulation of endometrial function. My talk was very well attended and I benefitted from presenting my work to a targeted audience. The question and answer session that followed my talk was very useful for gaining critical feedback and carried on into the coffee break that followed.
