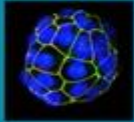
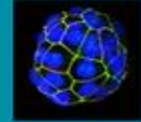

INSTRUCTIONS FOR POSTER PRESENTERS

Registration

Change of presenter

Should the name of the presenter change at a later date, please notify the Secretariat immediately.

Mounting and Removal of Posters

If the poster presenter is unable to meet the set-up or removal times, you must arrange for a co-author or other colleague to assist with set-up and/or removal.

Mounting of Posters

Friday 7 July 2017: Posters should be mounted between 09.30 – 09.55 hrs

Removal of Posters

Friday 7 July 2017: Posters should be removed immediately as the Symposium closes to allow for the room to be set up for dinner.

We regret that we are unable to forward posters to authors following the Symposium. Any posters remaining on boards after the close of the Symposium may be discarded.

Poster Sessions

Authors are requested to be available at their poster during breaks and lunch to discuss their poster with fellow delegates.

Storage of Poster Tubes and Packaging

Please do not leave your tube by your posterboard as it presents a health and safety hazard. Please ask at the Registration desk for where it can be stored. All poster presenters should ensure that their poster tubes are clearly labelled for identification purposes with your name and poster number.

PREPARING YOUR POSTER

YOUR POSTER NUMBER WILL BE PROVIDED AND DISPLAYED AT THE TOP OF THE POSTER BOARD

Not to exceed 900 mm

Please note the following instructions when preparing your poster

1. **Do NOT exceed the overall poster dimensions: (900 mm wide by 1200 mm high).**
2. Please **include the abstract title** at the top of your poster.
3. Please ensure that the text of the poster is clear and can be read from a distance of 2 metres - please read the guidelines on how to prepare your poster.
4. Posters should be attached to the boards by Velcro, which will be supplied by the organisers. Posters should therefore be made from **light-weight** materials.

All posters should be displayed for the duration of the Symposium.

Not to exceed 1200 mm
