The annual ESE meeting is the leading international conference on endocrinology in the Europe. The 4-day scientific programme was extensive and spanned many aspects of endocrinology, including symposiums, presentations, lectures and e-posters with relevance for the reproduction and my own research.

There were symposiums I found especially useful: "From the pituitary to the periphery", "The challenges of male fertility", "New roles for nuclear receptors", "Is cardiovascular risk increased in women with PCOS?", "Hyperandrogenism: challenges in clinical management", "Reproduction and endocrine disruption", "Sleep, love and reproduction" and plenary lectures: "Hormone-secreting adrenal tumors in pregnancy", "Unravelling the role of transient receptor potential channels in endocrine regulation and metabolism".

The program gave me lots of ideas for my own studies, in particular, for the study of the relationship between hormones and the breast, especially new hormones (kisspeptin). I was able to discuss my work with world experts in the endocrine and reproductive fields.
