## TRAVEL

### By Air

Southampton Airport is just an 11-minute drive from St Mary's Stadium.

A taxi from Southampton Airport to St Mary's Stadium costs approximately £14 each way.

The airport is based in Eastleigh and is adjacent to Southampton Airport Parkway (train station). Trains from here to Southampton Central run every 15 minutes, and can take as little as seven minutes to get in to Southampton.

### By Train

Southampton Central Station is located just over a mile away from St. Mary's Stadium. Southampton is served by trains from London, Gatwick Airport, Cardiff, Manchester and Brighton. Refer to [www.nationalrail.co.uk](http://www.nationalrail.co.uk) to plan your journey.

The approximate cost of a taxi from Southampton Central to St Mary's Stadium is £7 each way.
