I am working as assistant embryologist and in second year of my PhD degree in the field of sperm motility enhancer, and it is titled as "Structural modification of pentoxifylline (PTF) as an approach to reduce gamete toxicity induced pentoxifylline". In addition to this I am also working the field of fertility preservation in adult and prepubertal males using natural products. In my study I have found promising results with Indian propolis in mitigating the effects of chemotherapeutic drug such as mitomycin C.
